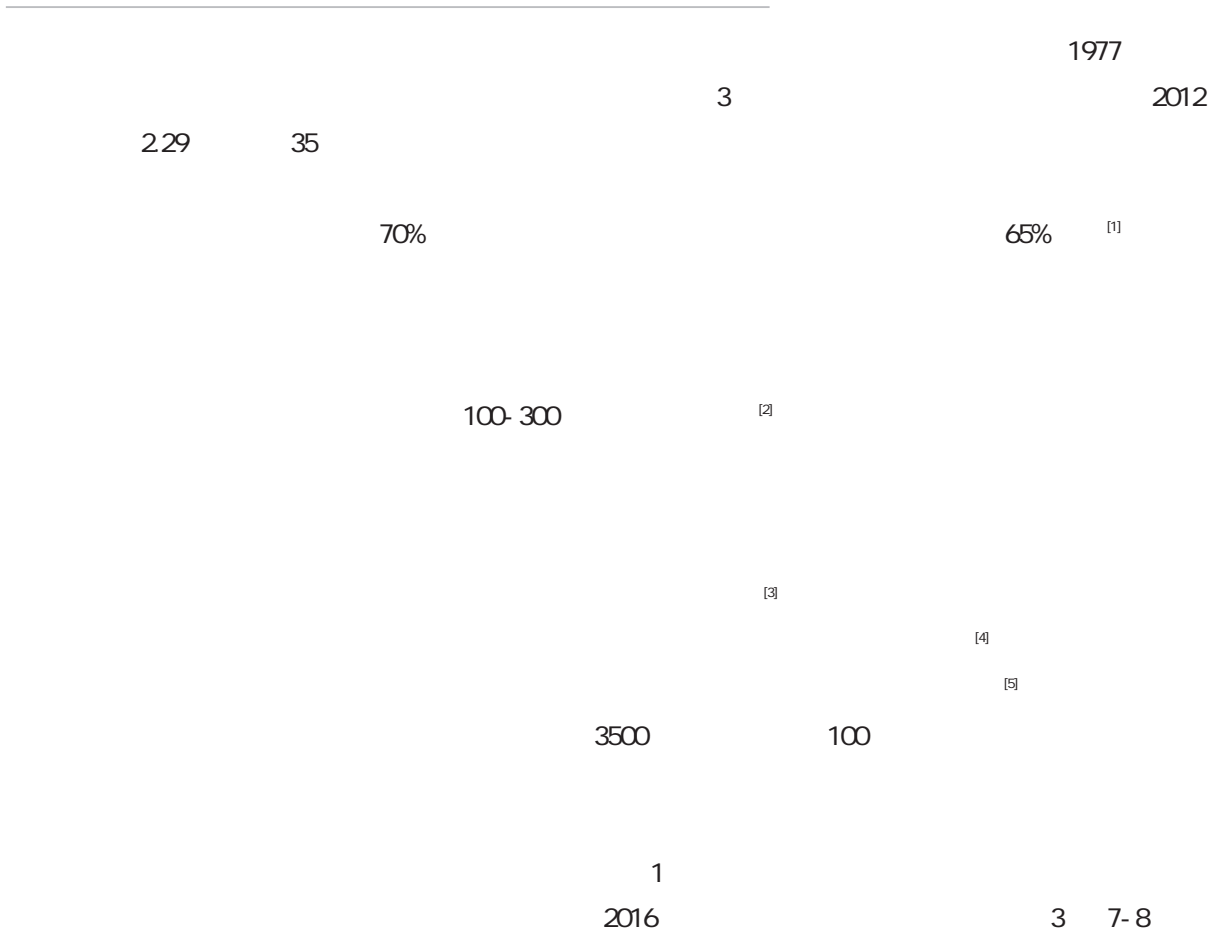

Family Farms: a Base for the Change of Farmers' Identity Based on the Investigation of Lujiang County, Anhui Province

Abstract: Urbanization, especially the new type of rapid development of urbanization, prompts more and more farmers to flow into cities and towns. Thus, some severe phenomena, including multiple job-holding production, sideline production and production mainly undertaken by old men, appeared in agricultural production. Therefore, some living-in-village farmers, including migrant workers flowing back home, transfer farmers' contracted land to establish family farms. The rise and development of family farms will put an end to the traditional agriculture, reduce small farmers, and change living-in-village farmers into professional farmers or city citizens with decent jobs.
